## Police departments

### 40 visits made to request access to chase policy

70 percent	Complied with the request (28 of 40 requests)
30 percent	Required identification for access to public records (12 of 40 requests)
27 percent	Required a reason for access (11 of 40 requests)

## School districts

### 44 visits made to request access to district crisis response plan

63 percent	Complied with the request (28 of 44 requests)
45 percent	Required identification for access to public records (20 of 44 requests)
31 percent	Required a reason for access (14 of 44 requests)

## Town offices

### 89 visits made to request access to attorney's fees paid in 2005

65 percent	Complied with the request (58 of 89 requests)
26 percent	Required identification for access to public records (24 of 89 requests)
32 percent	Required a reason for access (29 of 89 requests)

## Town offices

### 89 visits made to request access to tax liens, undischarged

59 percent	Complied with the request (53 of 89 requests)
23 percent	Required identification for access to public records (21 of 89 percent)
37 percent	Required a reason for access (33 of 89 requests)
